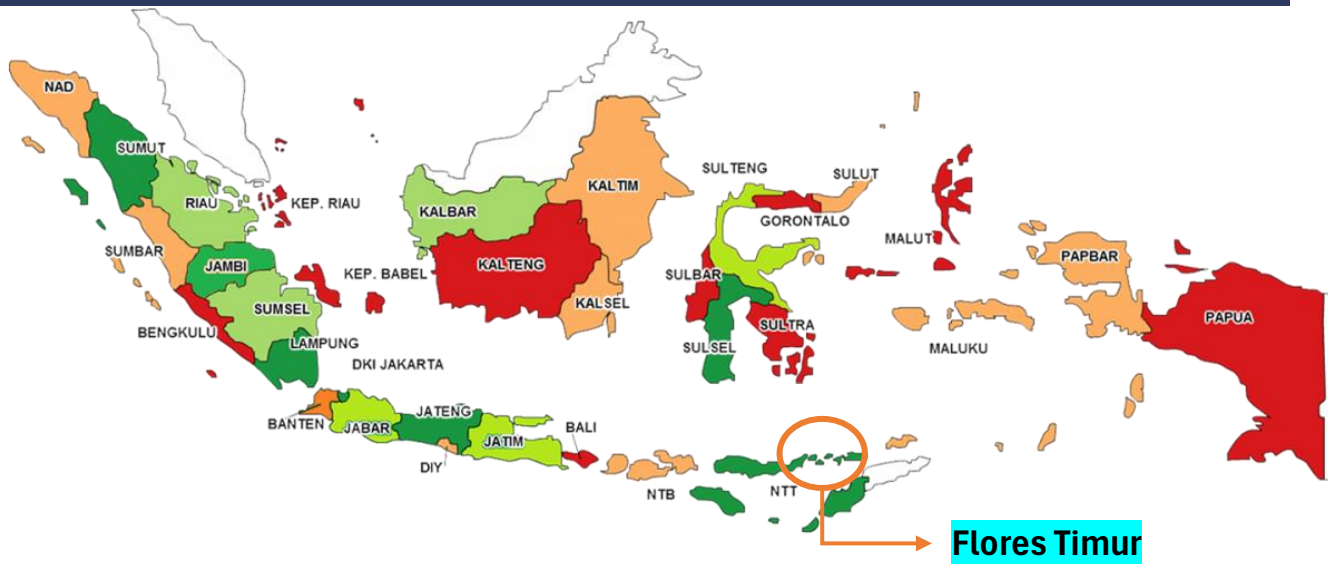

CHRONOLOGY OF THE DISASTER EVENTS

- Visual observations for the period 23 October - 3 November at 21.00 WITA, show that the volcanic activity of Mount Lewotobi Male has increased significantly and is currently at level IV (Dangerous).
- The types of earthquakes recorded during the period 23 October to 3 November at 18.00 WITA are: 43 eruption earthquakes, 28 gust earthquakes, 94 harmonic earthquakes, 7 Low Frequency earthquakes, 133 Shallow Volcanic earthquakes, 353 Deep Volcanic earthquakes, 26 Local Tectonic earthquakes, 68 Far Tectonic earthquakes, and 3 flood tremors.
- The Regent of East Flores declared the Status of Emergency Response to the Lewotobi Laki Volcano Eruption Natural Disaster Number: BPBD.300.2.2.5/24/BID.KL/IX/2024, for 58 days - starting from 04 November to 31 December 2024
- Danger area up to 9 kilometers

- Activating the Health/HEOC cluster with the Decree of the Head of Health Office No. 443.5/34/P2P/XI/2024
- Establishment of the Emergency Handling Command Post for the Natural Disaster of the Lewotobi Laki-laki Volcano Eruption based on the Decree of the Regent of East Flores No. 330 of 2024
- Provide logistics and health services in 44 evacuation shelter
- Deploying 559 people from the Nusa Tenggara Timur Provincial Health Reserve Team to 6 health posts in Titihena District, Flores Timur Regency
- Conducting data collection on pregnant women, as well as providing maternal and child health services in evacuation sites
- Distribution of blood-boosting drugs for pregnant women
- Providing a hotline for complaints of sexual harassment in evacuation posts
- Provision of sanitation & clean water

Perkumpulan Keluarga Berencana Indonesia (PKBI) is a nongovernmental organization (NGO) that pioneered the Family Planning movement in Indonesia. The birth of PKBI was motivated by the concerns of the founders of PKBI, consisting of a group of community leaders and health experts on various population issues and high maternal mortality rates in Indonesia. the importance of reproductive health services in times of emergency; as well as being the basis of the Paket Pelayanan Awal Minimum (PPAM / MISP) program for Reproductive Health, which was raised by the PKBI. PPAM for Reproductive Health is a set of coordinated priority activities, designed to meet the reproductive health needs of the population, at the beginning of an emergency / disaster. Departing from the principle of fulfilling the needs and services of Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights (HKSR), and the principle of Family Planning (KB), PKBI formed a humanitarian team at every level of work (center, region, and branch) to conduct reproductive health response efforts in times of emergency
